

### **Hidden Yard suggestions for rules:**

**"When you plan to set up a train in Hidden Yard, before changing the control to LOCAL, you must check with the operator of the main dispatch panel to see if any train is scheduled leave or to return to Hidden Yard. This will prevent situations where you would have a conflict between two trains using the same track in the Hidden Yard or one not able to leave."**

### **Operating Trains suggestion for rules:**

**No one, that isn't a member or a junior member, should be running trains. They should sit and watch. Also, they shouldn't bring their own equipment and expect to run it. The sponsor of the junior member, who brought a friend, should be responsible for the guest. Certainly, a regular member (ie like Ed), bringing down their child can let the child run a train if the member is with them.**

### **Junior Member suggestion for Rules:**

**Junior members that don't have clearance to run trains would need to have their sponsors with them and the operation of their train would be controlled by the person running the board, (they would be watching and learning the operation of the board, but could still operate a train. Instruction on operation would be passed along by the qualified member) whether it was a regular member or a qualified junior member, just like it would be for a show situation. They would be required to follow the directions of the dispatcher. If none was available, they would have to wait for one to show up and just not start running a train and/or setting up one.**
